

1. ICAO Level Three State Safety Programme (SSP) **Implementation Process**

Nigeria has attained the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) Level three State Safety Programme (SSP) Implementation Process Rating – a high level safety rating, which places the country among the world leaders in aviation safety.

- Somalian Government Honours Nigerian Policemen 2. The Somalian government has awarded medals to 136 Nigerian Policemen for their support towards peacekeeping in Somalia during their one year duty term.
- 3. 2016-2018 WASME Governing Board Alhaji Babale Umar Girie has emerged President with Dr. Dikko Umar Raddo, Dr. Ahmed M. - 2017 University of Oxford Rhodes Professorship 4. Wale Adebanwi has been appointed to the prestigious Rhodes Professorship in Race Relations in the School of Interdisciplinary Area Studies at the University of Oxford, United Kingdom – the first black African scholar

to be appointed to the endowed Chair since it was created more than 60 years ago.
